

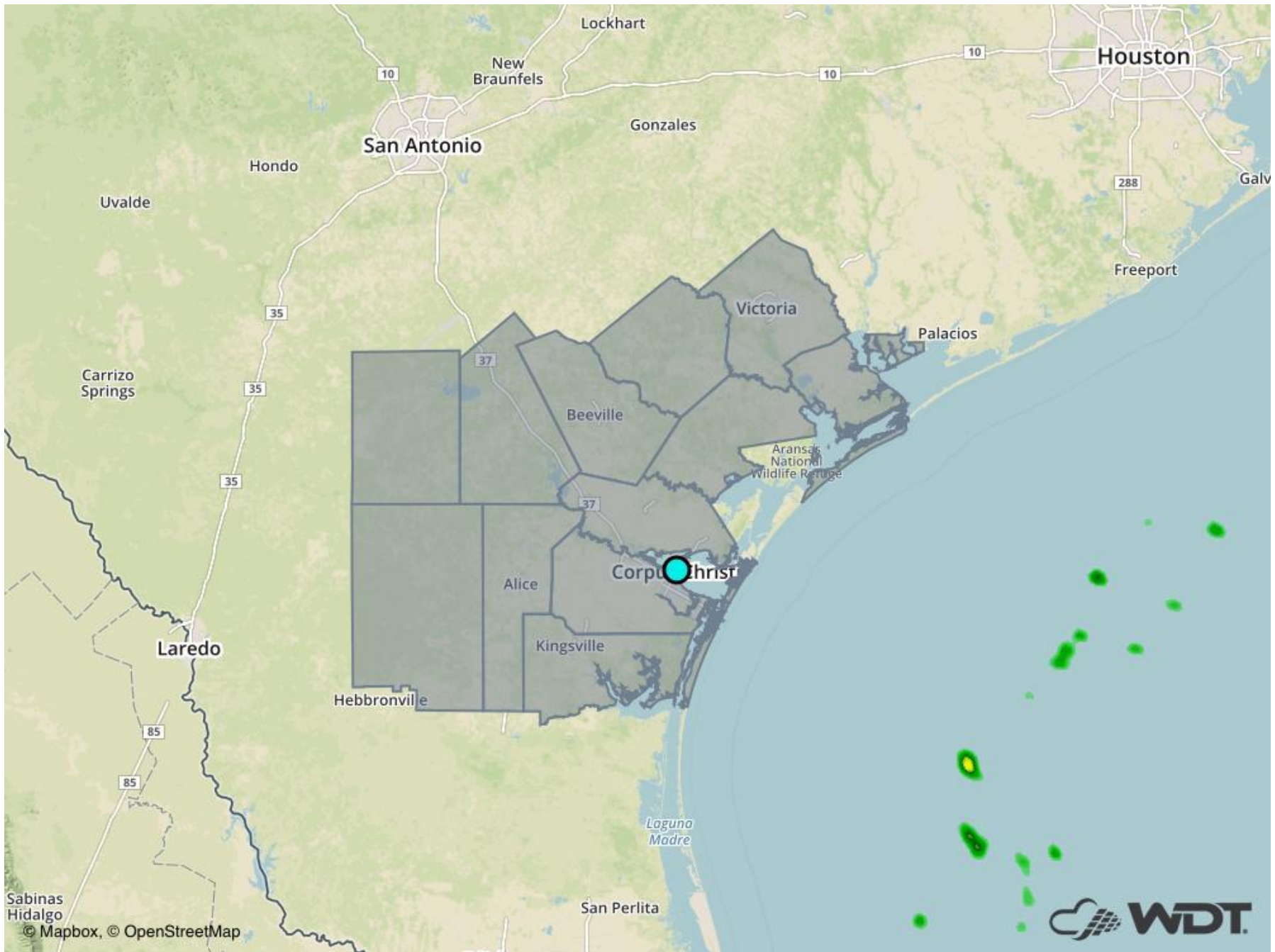

...Areas of Dense Fog Across Most of South Texas Early This Morning...

.Areas of dense fog will continue over the Coastal Bend and Victoria Crossroads region this morning and spread into the eastern portions of the Brush Country. The fog will restrict visibility to a quarter of a mile or less at times this morning. Visibilities are expected to improve an hour or two after sunrise.

...DENSE FOG ADVISORY IN EFFECT UNTIL 9 AM CST THIS MORNING...

The National Weather Service in Corpus Christi has issued a Dense Fog Advisory, which is in effect until 9 AM CST this morning.

* VISIBILITY...One quarter of a mile or less.

* IMPACTS...Hazardous driving conditions.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A Dense Fog Advisory means visibilities will frequently be reduced to less than one quarter mile. If driving...slow down... use low-beam headlights...and leave plenty of distance ahead of you.
