

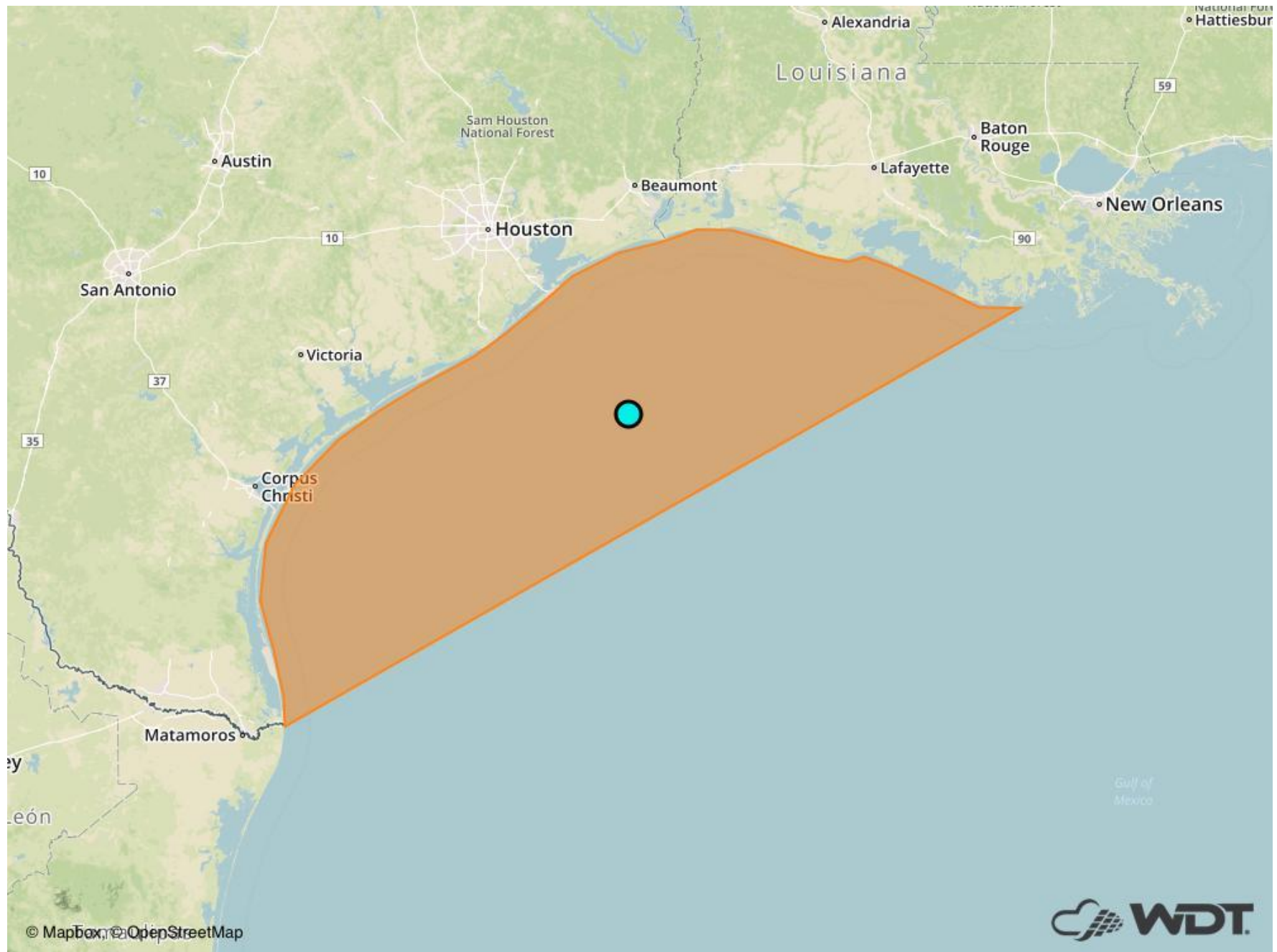

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Strong Cold Front Will Pass Into the Gulf on Friday

Threat Time: 12 AM CST Friday through 12 AM CST Saturday

Primary Impacts

Winds: 25-35 knots

Wind Shift: S-SW or Variable at 5-10 knots / N-NE at 25-35 knots

Wind Gusts: In excess of 40 knots

Seas:

Near Shore: 6-10 feet

Deep Waters: 8-13 feet

The next strong cold front is expected to move into the Gulf of Mexico on Friday, bringing a significant wind shift and enhanced conditions. The front will begin to move into the Gulf of Mexico very late on Thursday or the very beginning of the day on Friday, and continue across the basin through the remainder of the day. As the front moves through, winds will turn to out of the north to northeast and increase to around 25-30 knots, with higher gusts. Wave heights will increase accordingly as well. Plentiful precipitation is expected with the boundary, though strong thunderstorms are currently not expected.

This watch will be upgraded to a warning or updated with the latest information by around 12 AM CST Thursday.

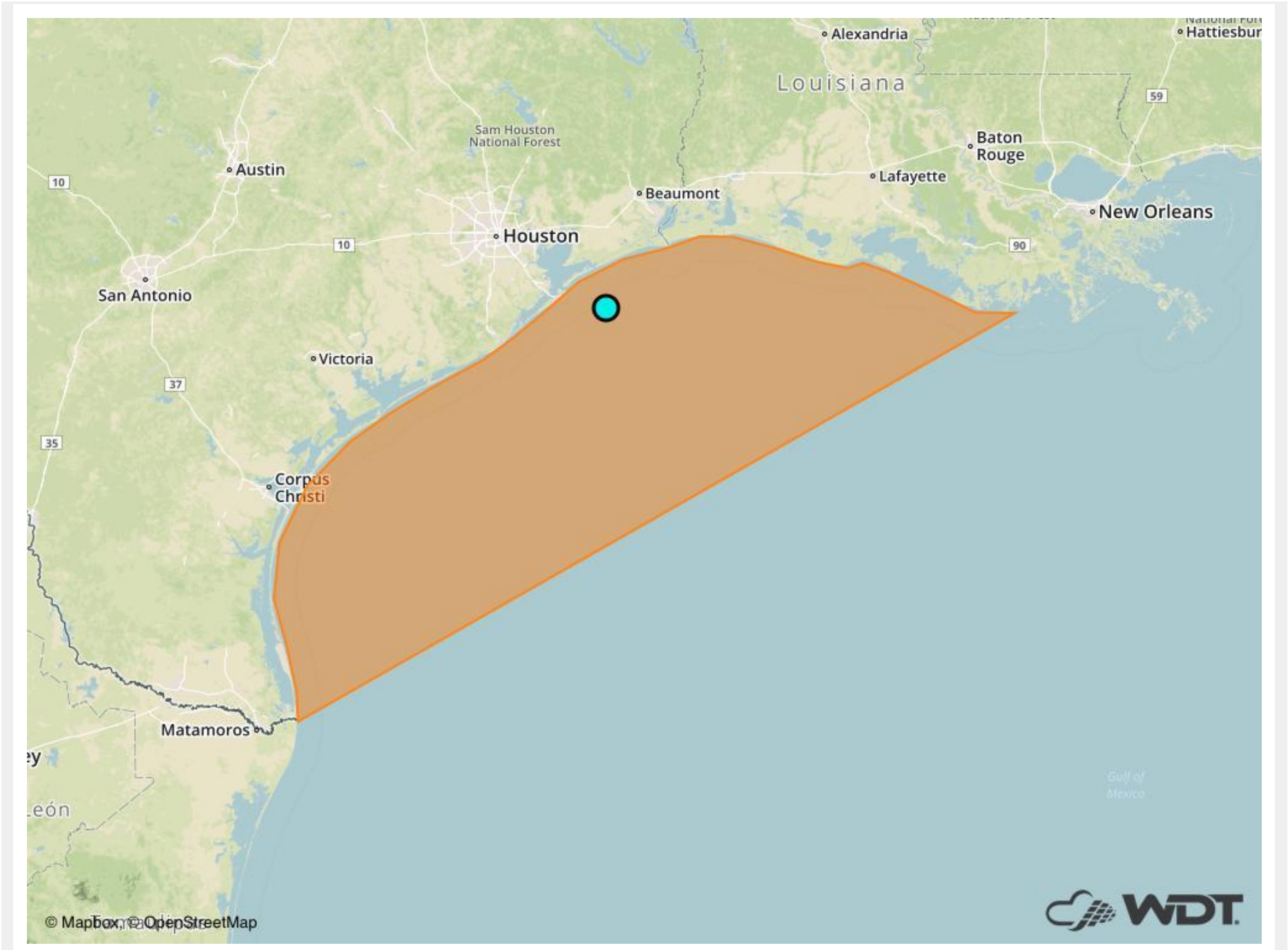
