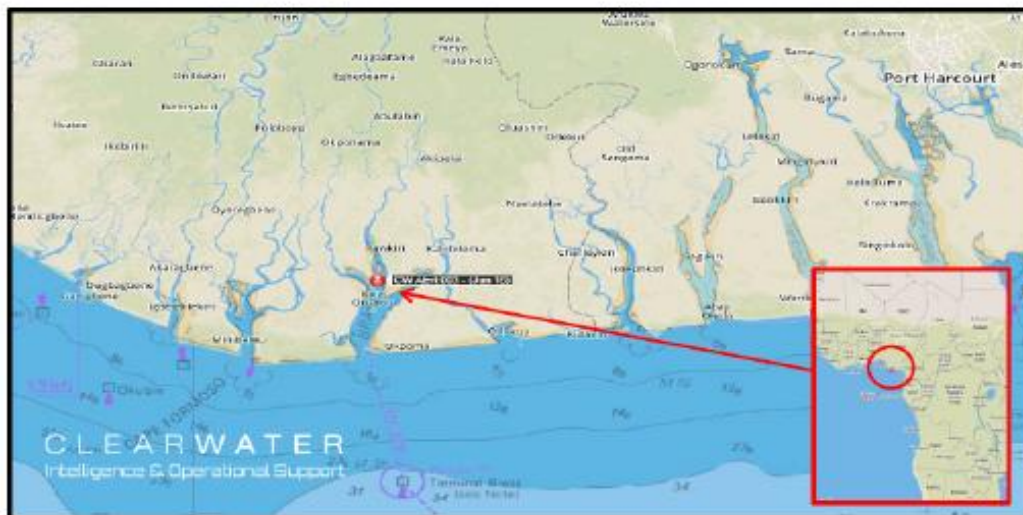

Description of event: PIRATE ATTACK

Bayelsa State, Nigeria

It has been reported that pirates have killed an executive member of Ijaw Youth Council Worldwide. The incident took place in the Brass waterways where the pirates ambushed and shot at the boat transporting the victim and forced the other passengers to flee into the mangroves. The victim is described as someone who has campaigned against illegal oil bunkering in the area. No further information has been received.
