

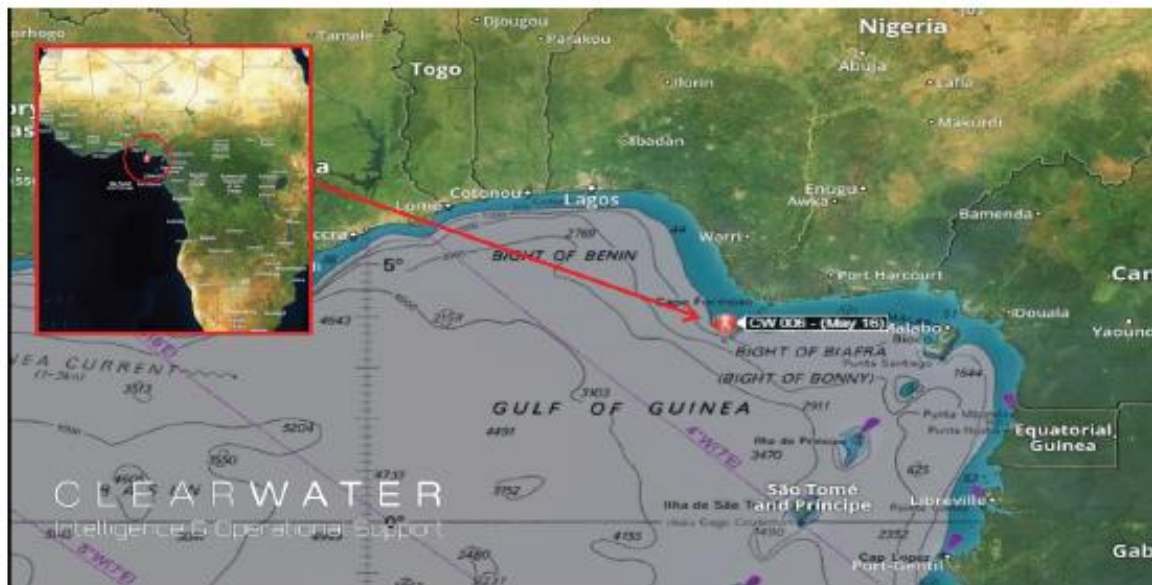

## NUMBER 006 – May 16

### Attack on vessel 25nm SW of Pennington Terminal, Nigeria - Attack

It has been reported by a PMSC that a vessel was chased by 2 Skiffs with armed men on board. The master increased speed and carried out evasive manoeuvres and the on board security team fired warning shots. Upon being fired upon the skiffs aborted their attempt and headed in a NW direction. The vessel is now continuing towards Lagos and all crew are reported safe. The same vessel was previously attacked in approximately the same position on 19/04/2016.
