### Obama, Bayelsa. Nigeria

It has been reported that a JTF gunboat on patrol was attacked by gun men on board a speed boat with a 200hp engine. The JTF were in transit of an official nature to an undisclosed location when the attack occurred. The JTF patrol repelled the attack killing four of the gun men however, one soldier received a gunshot wound to the leg and was evacuated to a nearby hospital for treatment.

It has been reported that the gunmen shot and killed two of the traders. They also injured a child and the Captain of the passenger boat.
